We pledge to deliver the highest level of customer service, which includes respecting your privacy and protecting your personal information. In this privacy statement ("Statement"), we provide you with details about how we collect, use, and disclose your personal information.

This Statement applies to Assembled Products Corporation, and all of its brands d.b.a. Jotto Desk, Mart Cart, and Spray Master Technologies (collectively, "APC," "we," or "us").

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## CHANGING AND ACCESSING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

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#### **CALIFORNIA CONSUMERS' RIGHTS**

The Right to Know, The Right to Delete, and the Right to Opt-Out of the Sale of Personal Information

APC does not currently sell any personal information. If and when APC does sell information, information for opt-out preferences will be added here.

#### Sensitive Personal Information

We limit the use of your personal information to that use which is pursuant to performing reasonably expected goods or services or as required by law.

#### Direct Marketing Disclosure

California consumers also may request information about our disclosures of certain categories of personal information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes. APC does not knowingly disclose or sell personal information for a third party's direct marketing purposes. In the event APC does enter into such an agreement, information for submitting requests will be posted here.

#### The Right to Non-Discrimination

The CCPA/CPRA prohibit a business from treating a consumer differently because the consumer exercised a right conferred on him/her by the CCPA/CPRA. We welcome you to exercise your rights under the CCPA/CPRA, and we will not discriminate against you for doing so.

#### Financial Incentive Notice

APC does not offer a financial incentive for the collection, sale, or deletion of personal information. As detailed in this Statement, APC primarily collects personal data from you in order to promote and fulfill orders for goods and services provided by APC and from account holders in order to operate programs under agreements with you. APC also collects personal data for marketing and other purposes as permitted by applicable law.

The ability for an account holder to access promotions and offerings is not directly related to the value provided to the business of your data.

#### Removal of Content

If you are a California resident under the age of 18, and a registered user of any site where this policy is posted, California Business and Professions Code Section 22581 permits you to request and obtain removal of content or information you have publicly posted. 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#### **NEVADA CONSUMERS' RIGHTS**

The Right to Opt-Out of the Sale of Personal Information

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## HOW WE PROTECT PERSONAL INFORMATION

We take reasonable measures to: (i) protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction, and (ii) keep personal information accurate and up-to-date as appropriate.

APC employs a team of dedicated information technology professionals who are responsible for managing APC's data security program. This team is responsible for, among many other things, monitoring our systems for protection against potential intrusions, responding to potential incidents, supporting information security, regularly reviewing and updating the security controls APC uses to protect data, and providing training on APC's information security program.

APC maintains a payment card industry ("PCI") compliance program.

We require third parties with whom we share personal information to exercise reasonable efforts to maintain the confidentiality of personal information.

We will never ask you to send us confidential personal information or payment card information via email or text message.

In the event of a security incident, APC will notify regulators and/or consumers as required by applicable laws and regulations.

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# DISCLOSURE PURSUANT TO LEGAL OBLIGATIONS OR TO PROTECT THE SAFETY AND SECURITY OF PEOPLE AND PROPERTY

APC will disclose personal information as required by law. Examples of such disclosures include when a law enforcement agency serves a valid subpoena on APC, and when a civil litigant serves a lawful discovery request on APC. APC may elect to share personal information with law enforcement or others as necessary to protect the safety and security of people and property, to pursue available remedies or limit the damages that we may sustain, and to respond to an emergency.

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## APPENDIX ADDITIONAL PRIVACY PROVISIONS REGARDING PROCESSING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION OF RESIDENTS OF CERTAIN COUNTRIES AND US STATES

This Appendix provides additional information for individuals residing in countries and U.S. states that have enacted privacy laws giving certain additional rights to residents of those jurisdictions. <u>Controller and Data Protection</u>: APC is the entity that processes your personal information and is responsible for Data Protection.

#### Purposes and Legal Basis for Processing

APC processes your personal information for the purposes set forth in the main body of this Statement.

The legal bases for APC's processing activities include processing such information as necessary to comply with our contractual obligations, compliance with our legal obligations, protecting the safety of our employees, vendor partners and others, for our legitimate business interests, and pursuant to your consent.

The particular legal basis for the processing of your personal information is based on the purpose for which such information was provided or collected:

Account Participation: We process the personal information obtained in connection with your establishing an account with us on the basis of our contractual relationship with you and in furtherance of our business interests, including to personalize your use of our services and applications, to communicate news and promotional items, and to deliver personalized advertising and content.

Surveys: Completion of surveys is voluntary – we process the information obtained from surveys on the basis of your consent and in furtherance of our business interests, including marketing, service improvements, and analytics.

On-property Collection: When you visit one of our properties, we collect your name, business entity name, along with the details of your stay (arrival and departure day and time), to comply with laws regarding your safety while a guest on our premises, and on the basis of our contractual relationship with you. We use closed circuit television and other security measures at our properties that may capture or record images of guests and visitors in public areas, as well as information related to your location while on our properties (via sign in/sign out procedures) for the protection of our staff, guests and visitors to our properties.

Social Media: Participation in APC-sponsored social media activities and offerings is voluntary - we process information obtained from social media participation on the basis of your consent and in furtherance of our related business interests, including for marketing, service improvements, and analytics and goods and service personalization, as described in the sections referenced above of our Global Privacy Statement.

<u>Promotions and Sweepstakes</u>: Participation in sweepstakes, contests and other promotional offerings is voluntary – we process the information obtained from such participation based on your consent and as necessary to administer the offering. We also use certain data for our business purposes, including for

marketing, service improvements, administration of programs, and analytics and service personalization, as described in the sections referenced above of our Global Privacy Statement.

<u>Direct Marketing:</u> We use your personal information to send you marketing messages on the basis of your consent. You may withdraw your consent for direct marketing communications at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions in the marketing message.

*Vendor, Service Partner, and other Opportunities:* We process this information on the basis of our contractual relationship with you and for our related business interests, including maintaining and promoting the APC brands and facilitating direct communication between properties within the APC portfolio of brands.

WMBE Suppliers: Participation in APC's surveys regarding supplier diversity is voluntary – we process this information based on your consent and for our related business interests, including ensuring non-discriminatory business practices.

Retention: We retain personal information about you for the time necessary to accomplish the purpose for which such information was collected, usually for the duration of any contractual relationship and for any period thereafter as legally required or permitted by applicable law. Our retention policies reflect the applicable statute of limitation periods and legal requirements.

Data Subject Rights: Residents of the EEA have the following rights:

Access, Correction and Erasure Requests: You have the right to:

- ask us to confirm whether we are processing your personal information receive information on how your data is processed obtain a copy of your personal information
- request that we update or correct your personal information
- request that we delete personal information in certain circumstances

Right to Object to Processing: You have the right to request that APC cease processing of your personal information:

- for marketing activities, including profiling for statistical purposes
- where such processing is based on our legitimate business interests, unless we can demonstrate a compelling legitimate basis for such processing or we need to process your personal information for the establishment, exercise or defense of a legal claim

Right to Restrict Processing: You have the right to request that APC limit the processing of your personal information:

- while APC is evaluating or in the process of responding to a request by you to update or correct your personal information where such processing is unlawful, and you do not want APC to delete your data
- where APC no longer requires such data, but you want us to retain the data for the establishment, exercise or defense of a legal claim
- where you have submitted an objection to processing based on our legitimate business interests, pending our response to such request
- Where we limit the processing of your personal information pursuant to your request, we will inform you prior to reengaging in such processing.

<u>Data Portability Requests</u>: You have the right to request that we provide you or a third party that you designate with certain of your personal information in a commonly used, machine readable format. Please note, however, that data portability rights apply only to personal information that we have obtained directly from you and only where our processing is based on consent or the performance of a contract.

We will respond to all such requests within 30 days of our receipt of the request, unless there are extenuating circumstances, in which event we may take up to 60 days to respond. We will inform you if we expect our response to take longer than 30 days. Please note, however, that certain personal information may be exempt from such rights pursuant to applicable data protection laws. In addition, we will not respond to any request unless we are able to appropriately verify the requester's identity. We may charge you a reasonable fee for subsequent copies of data that you request.

If you have concerns about our data practices or the exercise of your rights, you may either contact Assembled Products Corporation, Attn: Privacy Rights, 115 East Linden Street, Rogers, AR, 72756, USA or the supervisory authority in the Member State of your residence.

Right to Withdraw Consent: You have the right to withdraw your consent to any processing that we conduct solely based on your consent (such as sending direct marketing materials to your personal email account).
